The Lambeth Harmful Sexual Behaviour Forum offers support to practitioners working with children and young people presenting with Harmful Sexual Behaviour (HSB).

The forum takes place once a month and is facilitated by the Lead for the Lambeth HSB Service and a friendly, experienced multi-agency team including senior clinicians and practitioners.

The forum aims to provide a safe, supportive and reflective space for social workers, YOS officers, CAMHS practitioners, police officers and professionals from education, to discuss cases they are working with.

The forum can offer specialist advice and guidance on assessments, interventions, safety planning, formulations and referrals for specialist support.

The forum runs on the first Thursday morning of every month and is also the gateway to any referral into the Lambeth HSB Service for an AIM Assessment.
